<p><u>Phase 1B</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • People 65 years of age and older • Frontline essential workers in critical infrastructure which include food and agriculture workers, critical manufacturing workers, public transit workers, grocery store workers, U.S. Postal Service workers, workers with unique skill sets not covered above, such as non-hospital laboratories 	Yes	Grace Health patients who meet Phase 1B criteria may call Grace Health at (484) 212-5936 to schedule an appointment.
